	<p style="text-align: center;">230. PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS</p> <p>1. Purpose The Board recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in public events.</p> <p>2. Authority The Board endorses such performances when they constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational program; they do not interfere with other scheduled activities of the school; and the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety and well-being of the students who will be involved.</p> <p>All requests for public performances by student groups require the approval of the Board of Directors.</p> <p>3. Delegation of Responsibility The Superintendent shall develop procedures to implement this policy which require that: parental permission is sought and received before students may participate; no student is compelled to participate in an extra curricular public performance or penalized in any way for failure to do so; no student, group of students or employees of this Board may receive compensation for the performance in public of students organized as a school representative; and the interests of students are protected and guarded against exploitation.</p> <p><u>Contests</u></p> <p>No student shall represent the District in any form of contest outside the schools without the approval of the Superintendent.</p> <p>No non-school activity or contest shall be conducted within the schools of the District without the approval of the Superintendent.</p>
