PARTICIPATION IN SCHOOL AFFAIRS</p> <p>The Board believes that students should participate in the governance of school activities at levels appropriate to their ages and competencies.</p> <p><u>Attendance at Conventions</u></p> <p>Students who attain a state or national office in a school-related student organization may be granted permission to attend the state and/or national conventions of such organizations at the discretion of the Board. A student may not attend more than one state and one national convention in any school year. Expenses to conventions authorized by the Board will be paid by the school district as incurred but shall not exceed \$300 per trip.</p> <p>When a faculty member accompanies a student to a convention of a student organization, s/he shall follow the released time procedures as outlined in school district regulations.</p> <p>Rules and regulations as outlined in Article II, section B, of Regulation 431-R regarding expenses shall apply to students as well as faculty members.</p> <p><u>Contests</u></p> <p>No student shall represent the Center Area School District in any form of contest outside the schools without the approval of the Superintendent.</p> <p>No non-school activity or contest shall be conducted within the schools of the district without the approval of the Superintendent.</p>
