



Dear Central Valley School District Parents/Guardians,

The School Health law mandates that medical examinations shall be provided for all children of school age upon original entry into school, Kindergarten (or 1st Grade), in the 6th grade and in the 11th grade. Dental examinations are mandated upon entry into school, Kindergarten (or 1st Grade), in the 3rd grade and in the 7th grade. These grades were selected because they represent critical periods of growth and development in a child's life.

Although the school district will provide these examinations during the school year, we are recommending that they be done by your family physician and dentist since they can best evaluate your child's health and assist you in obtaining necessary treatments and corrections.

An examination done by the family dentist or doctor within one (1) year prior to the opening of school and recorded on the form provided by the school is accepted for the required examination that year.

Immunizations must be up to date before a student is admitted to school.

We are sending the forms to you early, so that you may have an opportunity to have the examinations completed by the time your child reaches the designated grades. Please have them filled in as completely as possible and return them to our school nurse.
