202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS	
1. Purpose SC 501	The Board shall operate the schools of this District for the benefit of children resident in this District and eligible for attendance.
SC 1301	The Board may permit the admission of nonresident students in accordance with terms of this policy.
SC 1302	The Board reserves the right to verify the residency of any student and to require a sworn statement of residential support for the student who resides with a person other than his/her parent, guardian or custodian.
2. Authority	A. <u>Nonresident Children Placed In The District</u>
SC 1305	Any child placed in the home of a resident of this District by a court or an agency of government shall be admitted to the schools and shall receive the same benefits and be subject to the same duties as resident children.
	B. <u>Inmates Of Institutions</u>
SC 1306-9 SC 1309	A child who is an inmate of an institution for the care or training of children located within this District, is not a legal resident of the District by such placement, but shall be admitted to the schools of this District and a charge shall be made for tuition in accordance with statute.
	C. <u>Future Residents</u>
SC 1316	Nonresident students may be permitted to attend the Center Area School District schools for a maximum of ninety (90) school days at the beginning of the school term if a home is under construction in the District and will be completed in that time or if the parents are reasonably sure that a home will be available during that period of time. The District reserves the right to charge tuition to the parents for such attendance beginning with the first day of attendance if these conditions are not met.

<p>SC 1316</p>	<p>D. <u>Former Residents</u></p> <p>The District will permit the attendance of nonresident pupils in order to complete their senior year of education and graduation without payment of tuition, if and only in the event that the following conditions are met and satisfied:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The child was enrolled as a resident pupil of the District during the ninth, tenth and eleventh grades of such child's education.</li> <li>2. The parents of such child must declare in writing that the child will be fully supported by them continuously throughout the remainder of the child's senior year of education and graduation and that such parents will continue to assume all personal obligations for the child relative to school requirements.</li> <li>3. The District reserves the right to attach such further terms and conditions as it may determine to be reasonably warranted to effect the purpose of this regulation.</li> <li>4. The parents be solely responsible for transportation and other normal student activity fees which are usually required.</li> </ol>
<p>SC 1302</p>	<p>E. <u>Other Nonresident Students</u></p> <p>A nonresident student may be admitted to this District without payment of tuition where attendance is justified on the grounds that the student lives full-time and not just for the school year with District residents who have assumed legal guardianship of the student or is visiting this country as an exchange student and lives in the District.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the enrollment of nonresident children which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Admit such children only on the proper application of the parent or guardian.</li> <li>2. Do not exclude any child, otherwise eligible, on the basis of such child's race, creed, color, national origin, or ancestry.</li> <li>3. Verify claims of residency.</li> <li>4. Make continued enrollment of any nonresident student contingent upon maintaining good standards of citizenship and discipline.</li> </ol> <p>The Superintendent shall recommend to the Board for their approval the admission of qualified applicants.</p>
