
### **Face Coverings**

As of June 28, 2021, face coverings are no longer required. Face coverings remain optional at this time. The District will continue to receive information from the CDC and PA Department of Health regarding face coverings. Should staff or students choose to wear face coverings:



- Parents/guardians are responsible for providing face coverings for their child.
- Staff are responsible for providing their own face coverings.

#### Transportation

The District contracts with ABC Transit and Frye Transportation for bussing services. They are responsible for the daily sanitization of busses in accordance with company regulations and CDC guidelines.



## **Educational Pathways**

#### In-Person

Students will attend school in-person for the 2023-2024 school year.

#### <u>Central Valley Online Academy (CVOA)</u>

Asynchronous learning through CVOA is an option for students in grades K–12. Students may transition from cyber to face-to-face instruction at the end of each grading period only.

#### \*Synchronous Instruction

Synchronous instruction will be available for students with medical issues that require a temporary leave from the classroom based on Covid-related illness or quarantine. These situations will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis at the sole discretion of the district. You must contact your child's building principal and allow time for administrative review.

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## **Social Distancing**

As of May 31, 2021, physical distancing and capacity restrictions are no longer a requirement. The District will continue to receive information from the CDC and PA Department of Health regarding physical distancing.

# **Shared Materials**

Students will share educational materials as appropriate. Proper disinfection and hygiene practices will be observed when using shared materials.

# **Physical Education Classes**

Traditional physical education classes will continue for the 2023–2024 school year. The locker rooms will be used for middle and high school students to change before and after gym class.

# Gatherings

As of May 31, 2021, physical distancing and capacity restrictions are no longer a requirement. Concerts, assemblies, field trips, events, and other extracurricular activities will continue as feasible. Some events will also be live-streamed in addition to inperson performances.

# **Health Screens**

Staff and students will be encouraged to complete a selfassessment for COVID-19 symptoms prior to leaving for work or school.

# Volunteers

Volunteers will be permitted in the school when appropriate.

#### **Food Service**

There are no waivers available to allow for the district to provide free meals to all students regardless of lunch status. In order to apply for free or reduced lunch, please visit the district website or contact the Food Service Director.

# Disinfecting

The facilities department is in continual contact with the district administration and school health department to ensure the proper preventative measures are being taken to address possible exposure to COVID-19 in the schools.
