### SELECTION COMMITTEE GUIDELINES

## I Scholarship

85.000% GPA or better eligibility requirement

• Juniors: The average will include freshmen and sophomore year.

85.000% GPA or better eligibility requirement

• Seniors: The average will include freshmen, sophomore and junior year.

Rating: Each student receives a rating equivalent to his/her Grade Point Average.

\*\*Percentages will be converted into the 4.0 scale. Student's percentage will be multiplied by 4.0. Example: 97.35 = 0.9735\*4.0= 3.894= 3.89\*\*

#### **II** Character

• Juniors: Character will be based on sophomore year and first nine weeks of junior year.

• Seniors: Character will be based on junior year and first nine weeks of senior year.

Behavior: Each student receives a rating of 4.0. This rating is automatically

given to each student unless a behavior problem, or one involving social conduct as written by legislature, has been established. A deduction of 0.3 will be made for each negative comment up to a maximum of three negative comments. If a student receives four or more negative comments, he/she receives a zero (0) for character.

Absences: 0.1 point deduction for **EACH** unexcused absence.

Tardies: 0.1 point deduction for **EACH** unexcused tardy.

Suspensions: A student will receive zero points for **ANY** out of school suspension

during ANY point in his/her high school years.

<u>Detentions</u>: 0.2 point deduction for <u>EACH</u> after school detention, office

detention, or Saturday detention.

## III Leadership---Must be a member in the club/activity for a FULL year.

- A Each student will receive a 4.0 rating for <u>holding</u> any combination of two (2) or more offices or varsity letters and being a member of that club or sports team for a MINIMUM of two years:
  - Approved service organization
  - Central Valley High School club
  - Central Valley High School athletic team
- B Each student will receive a 3.5 rating for <u>holding</u> one office or one letter and being a member of that club or sports team for a MINIMUM of two years:
  - Approved service organization
  - Central Valley High School club
  - Central Valley High School athletic team
- C Each student will receive a 3.0 rating for <u>being</u> a member of TWO (2) or more of the following for a MINIMUM of two (2) years <u>but not</u> holding an office or lettering:
  - Approved service organization
  - Central Valley High School club
  - Central Valley High School athletic team
- D Each student will receive a 2.5 rating for <u>being</u> a member of any ONE (1) of the following for a MINIMUM of TWO (2) years but not holding an office or lettering:
  - Approved service organization
  - Central Valley High School club
  - Central Valley High School athletic team
- E Each student will receive a 0.0 rating for no participation as per A D.

#### IV Service

\*\*Service is defined as voluntary work intended to help people in a particular way.

The service form must be filled out with a detailed explanation to prove/explain the type of service that was provided. An adult who overlooked the service must sign this form. The adult <u>MUST</u> be someone other than a family member. A phone number must also be given. Failure to have the information will result in those hours being excluded from the final tally. **SERVICE MUST BE LISTED IN HOURS!** 

## THE DOCUMENTED HOURS WILL BE GIVEN THE FOLLOWING SCORES:

- 80 hours or greater = 4.0
- 70 79 = 3.8
- 60 69 = 3.6
- 50-59=3.4
- 40 49 = 3.0
- 30-39=2.8
- 20-29=2.4
- 10-19=2.2
- 0-9=0.0

#### V. Tally

Each student's sum total will be divided by four (4). An average of no less than 3.600 will be necessary for admittance to the National Honor Society.

Note: The committee will examine each application and determine that it was done in a manner appropriate with the dignity and ideals that is representative of this organization.

Note: If you are accepted into NHS, you will be required to participate in MANY mandatory activities

<sup>\*</sup>Hours counted can start in the student's freshmen year.

<sup>\*</sup>Hours that count towards a grade (ex: band, chorus, etc.) do not count towards service hours.

<sup>\*</sup>A maximum of 10 hours per year used for senior projects can be used for the NHS service requirement.

<sup>\*</sup>Fundraising for sports or clubs is not service hours.
