

These instructions outline the procedures to address a student with an illness or injury on the school bus.

- 1. The bus driver will immediately contact dispatch upon discovering a student with an illness or injury requiring medical assistance.
- 2. The bus driver will provide the location and a brief description of the emergency.
- 3. Dispatch will immediately call 911 to request medical assistance.
- 4. Dispatch will contact the bus driver via radio and ask for the student's name and school. The bus driver will communicate this information if possible.
- 5. Dispatch will review the student's medical conditions (if on file).
- 6. Dispatch will report any known medical conditions to 911.
 - If student medical conditions are not on file, but surface in communication with the school, dispatch will update 911.
 - Do not communicate the student medical conditions over the radio network.
- 7. Dispatch will contact the school office and the Director of Transportation to report the student medical emergency.
- 8. District representation will be on-site as soon as possible to assist the emergency responders (as appropriate).
- 9. School personnel will communicate with the student's family in regards to the medical emergency.
- 10. The Director of Transportation will inform the Superintendent about the medical emergency. A summary document including all relevant details will be recorded and placed on file.
- 11. Following an incident, procedures will be reviewed to determine the need for any adjustments.
