As we close in on the September 6, 2017 start date, I wanted to bring everyone up to speed on the renovation project. Let me start by assuring everyone that school will start on time as projected. The contractors and District custodial and maintenance staff have been working diligently to make sure that the building is ready to accept staff and students. The code inspector has toured the building on several occasions and is pleased and satisfied the we have gone above and beyond to ensure the building is safe for occupancy and within all code compliance for egress, emergency exiting, emergency lighting, separation of construction zones from staff and student occupied areas, etc...

When school begins on Wednesday, there will be changes on how we accept cars for parent and Latchkey drop off. In collaboration with our bussing company and Center Township Police Department, we have adjusted the route for morning drop off. Cars will now be directed through the parking lot adjacent to the football field. The new traffic pattern should help to ease the congestion on Baker Road and back to Todd Lane. Upon arrival on campus, a township officer and District workers will be in place to direct and monitor traffic. We ask that you drop students off along the sidewalk located next to the school and move on so that other cars can get into the loop in front of the main entrance. Do not wait until you get to the front door to drop off your child. School staff will be waiting to greet the children along the sidewalk and at the front door.
